From 1 July 2019	Applications will be accepted for the registration and recording of animals: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• previously registered with the Boran Association of Australia [BAA]• that are the offspring of an ASBI registered sire and dam• that are first cross (F1) – with an ASBI registered Full blood or Purebred sire or dam• born prior to 31 December 2012, and that meet the standard eligibility criteria set out in the <i>ASBI Herd Book – Regulations and procedures</i>.
From 1 Aug. 2019	Applications will be accepted for the registration and recording of animals: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• as listed above• born prior to 30 June 2014, and that meet the standard and/or Temporary Transition criteria set out in the <i>ASBI Herd Book – Regulations and procedures</i>.
From 1 Sept. 2019	Applications will be accepted for the registration and recording of animals: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• as listed above• that are second cross (F2), and the offspring of an ASBI registered and recorded parent• born prior to 31 December 2015, and that meet the standard and/or Temporary Transition criteria set out in the <i>ASBI Herd Book – Regulations and procedures</i>.
From 1 Oct. 2019	Applications will be accepted for the registration and recording of animals: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• as listed above• born prior to 30 June 2017, and that meet the standard and/or Temporary Transition criteria set out in the <i>ASBI Herd Book – Regulations and procedures</i>.
From 1 Nov. 2019	Applications will be accepted for the registration and recording of animals: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• as listed above• that are third cross (F3), and the offspring of an ASBI registered and recorded parent• born prior to 30 June 2019, and that meet the standard and/or Temporary Transition criteria set out in the <i>ASBI Herd Book – Regulations and procedures</i>.
